1. OBJECT AND GOAL

Wishing to offer new services to its clients, the Geneva Palexpo Foundation has installed and now operates WiFi 802.11 b/g on the Geneva Palexpo site.

As a direct result, from now on all WiFi installations are subject to special rules and to be limited to a bare minimum. All the users of this technology, the organisers and exhibitors at Geneva Palexpo, must scrupulously observe the following conditions, in order that all parties may benefit from an appropriate quality of service.

These rules are part of the obligations to be complied with in any case and automatically agreed by any Organizer or Exhibitor at Geneva Palexpo since they have been adopted with the express intention of improving the service for all our customers

2. STANDARDS AND CHANNELS AVAILABLE

The standards and channels available at Geneva Palexpo are:

- Standard 802.11 a – part of the channels – To be programmed as automatic;
- Standard 802.11 b – Channel 11 only;
- Standard 802.11 g – Channel 11 only.

3. SIGNAL STRENGTH AND SSID

The signal strength is to be restricted to cover the stand alone.

The use of your SSID in broadcast mode is strictly forbidden.

4. OBLIGATION TO DECLARE THE INSTALLATION

All WiFi installations must be systematically announced to the Geneva Palexpo telematics service by e-mail at:

telematics@geneva-palexpo.ch and should include the following information :

- a. Name and stand number;
- b. Name of contact person present on site at the opening of the event, with email address and mobile phone number;
- c. E-mail address of the chief technician in charge, as well as his/her mobile phone number;
- d. Make and model of the WiFi Access Point equipment;
- e. SSID(s) which is/are to be parametered (Broadcasting not permitted);
- f. Output strength to be used;
- g. Radio channel/frequency to be used, in compliance with the present document;
- h. Precise plan showing the location(s) of the Access Point(s) on the stand;
- i. Proposed dates during which installation is to be used (build-up, dismantling, event itself).

Information requested has to be given the day before the opening of the event at the latest.

5. SANCTIONS

Wifi 802.11 a/b/g equipment which does not observe the present rules and therefore disturbs the network, is to be deactivated immediately upon request from Geneva Palexpo staff.

Only a change in the configuration will allow the equipment to be reactivated.

Geneva Palexpo is also entitled to request the dismantling of any WiFi installation which has not been declared in advance.

In any event, the costs relating to the identification and locating of any such equipment, as well as any costs involved by the non-observance of these rules, will be charged to the stand concerned.
